

### **Pima County Superior Court Tour**

Camp attendees will have the opportunity to tour the <u>Arizona Superior Court in Pima County</u>, observe morning criminal calendar proceedings, meet with a judge, and attend a trial (if one is in session) or observe alternate proceedings.

Attendees for the court tour **must meet at the Superior Court at 110 West Congress Street at 8:00AM**. After the tour students will be chaperoned by Camp Officials to The James E. Rogers College of Law via public transportation (<u>Sun Link Streetcar</u>) for lunch at the law school and remainder of the afternoon camp activities. Students who self-transport to the courthouse are responsible for returning to the law school in time for lunch (12:00PM).

I understand that there are certain risks of injury inherent in travel via public transportation. Such risks may include, without limitation, criminal or negligent acts of third parties and road or traffic safety hazards. On behalf of myself and my child, I hereby unconditionally and irrevocably release, hold harmless and agree to fully indemnify the University of Arizona, the Arizona Board of Regents, and the State of Arizona, and any employees or agents of same, from and against any and all lawsuits, claims, demands, actions, suits, causes of action, liability, losses or damages, and any fees/ expenses/costs, of any kind whatsoever (including attorneys' fees and costs), whether known and unknown, that may arise from or are related to travel via public transportation.
